

# Parent Information 2015-2016

## Book Days:

Wed. July 29<sup>th</sup> from 11 am-6 pm

Thurs. July 30<sup>st</sup> from 11 am-6 pm

Fri. July 31<sup>st</sup> from 8-11 & 12-3. (Closed 11-12 for lunch)

- It is the parent's responsibility to take care of book fees DURING BOOK DAYS. **If you believe you may qualify for assistance for textbooks and/or meals, you should apply for this assistance during Book Days.**
  - You do not have to be on Food Stamps to apply, but if you are, please bring your 10-digit case number. This will expedite your application.
  - If you do not complete the application prior to the first day of school, your child will be charged full prices for meals until your application is turned in and approved.
  - You may also put money on your child's meal account
- Class lists will be posted in the cafeteria during Book Days!
- There will be forms that need to be filled out annually. Please have ONE adult stop in the office and see Mrs. Richter to get your child's Confidential Student Information Sheet to be updated.
- Due to summer maintenance, the building will not be open beyond the office, lobby & cafeteria. Be sure to plan to attend Open House! (see details, below)
- One of our nurses will be available during most hours of Book Days. Please turn in your Health Form to them and discuss any health concerns or immunization questions you have at this time.

## Student Meal Prices for 2015-2016

Breakfast: \$1.25 (.30 reduced)

Lunch: \$2.20 (.40 reduced)

*Most months have approximately 20 school days. 20 days @ \$2.20 = \$44.00*

**OPEN HOUSE will be Tues, August 4<sup>th</sup>, from 4:30 PM-6:00 PM.**

This is the afternoon before school starts.

## The First Day of School is Wed., Aug. 5<sup>th</sup>!

*Be sure to talk with your bus driver by the first of August.*

**Classes begin at 8:10.** *Students are expected to be in their seats, and not just entering the front doors at this time. Busses unload at 7:43. Car riders who eat breakfast at school should arrive at the same time. If not eating breakfast, car riders should arrive no later than 8 AM to be in class on time. (Our car-rider policy is on our website and will be in our handbook-coming home soon)*



## **WEARING SHORTS:**

*Students may wear shorts to school as long as the **forecast calls for 70 degrees at noon**—Shorts must be long enough for fingertips to touch the hem when child is standing up straight.*

## Changes in your Child's Dismissal:

*For your child's safety, we discourage frequent changes to your child's end of day routine. If the need does arise that there is a change, PLEASE SEND A NOTE TO SCHOOL WITH YOUR CHILD. THESE END-OF-DAY CHANGES ARE HANDLED FIRST THING IN THE MORNING WITH BUS PASSES AND CAR-RIDER NOTES SO THAT INSTRUCTION TIME IS NOT INTERRUPTED.*

*If it is necessary to make a change later in the day, we must be notified by 2:00 PM. This allows for us to get word to your child in a timely manner. Please contact Mrs. Richter in the school office at 812-623-2235, ext. 15903. Please note that some bus routes are at capacity, and there isn't room for additional passengers.*

*We have 2 Bus Dismissals along with our Car-Rider Dismissal. Last minute changes can lead to confusion for children. We appreciate our parents helping us to have smooth dismissals. This helps us get students home to a safe place.*
